## GENERAL INFORMATION

### Club Office Hours

Visitors are asked to register at the Club reception upon arrival to the clubhouse.

### Clubhouse Accommodation

The clubhouse has 19 guest rooms that can be single / twin or double rooms. Each room has its own ensuite, television, telephone, reverse cycle air conditioning, hair dryer and tea & coffee making facilities. A guest laundry is also available on the first floor of the clubhouse.

Full Board and Bed & Breakfast packages are offered to house guests and can be discussed by phoning the club office.

### Dining Services

Members and house guests are invited to use dining facilities:

- Breakfast served in our Links Room from 7am to 9am
- Lunch is available from 11.30am to 3pm
- Dinner in our Formal Dining Room from 6.30pm to 8pm

### Motorised Carts

The Club has a fleet of motorised carts for hire. Please enquire at Reception or the Professional Shop to make a booking.

Motorised carts may only be used during competitions for medical reasons — a medical certificate will be required. They can be used by any player in social events.

## IN THE CLUBHOUSE

### Members Bar, Verandah Bar, Links Room

- Neat casual dress including golf or tennis attire is acceptable in these areas.
- Boat shoes without socks are acceptable.
- Soft spikes may be worn. Shoes must be clean and tidy.

### Dining Room

- Men are required to wear a jacket and collared shirt. A tie is optional.
- Women are required to dress to an equivalent standard.

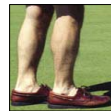
**A jacket and tie may be required on occasions for specific events or functions.**

### NOT ACCEPTABLE

#### Men and Women

Denim garments are not permitted in the Clubhouse or on the Course for persons aged 18 years or older. Tee shirts, beach wear, close fitting garments (eg leggings), tracksuits, reef sandals and thongs are unacceptable. Hats and caps are not to be worn inside the clubhouse.

### MOBILE PHONES

Mobile phones should not be used except for emergencies. If phones are left on, they should be in silent mode.



### Smoking

Smoking is **NOT** permitted in any part of the Clubhouse

## GOLF ETIQUETTE

- Take steps to ensure that your play does not affect the safety of staff and other golfers on the course.
- Play without delay. Be at the tee well before your starting time. Prepare to play your shot while others are playing theirs. Never mark your card when it's your turn to play. Allow faster players to play through. Aim to complete your round within 4 hours.
- Care for our links as if they were your own. Repair divots by filling them with sand - remember sand buckets are compulsory. Carefully rake and leave the rake facing toward the greens in the centre of the bunker.
- Repair damage to the green caused by the impact of the ball, the flag stick, or other golfers. Only repair spike marks after you have finished putting.
- The use of golf carts is a privilege not a right. They are to be driven at a responsible speed and NOT in front of greens or on the side of tees.
- Player only to look for lost golf ball. If in doubt, play a provisional.
- Grounds staff have right of way. Proceed with caution.
- When on the course, the Club has a supply of disposable canisters available on the 1<sup>st</sup> tee for smokers to take with them when playing their round. This should be disposed in the normal rubbish bins when you have finished your round.
- PACE of PLAY - The expectation is that you will complete your round of golf within 4 hours.

A little attention to these etiquette points should mean a pleasant days golf for everyone.

#### **Please remember :**

- 1. Use a sand bucket**
- 2. Repair damage to the course**
- 3. Play without delay - no more than 4 hours.**
