

THE BARWON HEADS GOLF CLUB

TEMPORARY LOCAL RULES

GROUND UNDER REPAIR

All areas as clearly marked (**Rule 25-1**)

All GUR stakes, signs and ropes are immovable obstructions. (**Rule 24-2**)

17th HOLE

The works area surrounding the 17th green defined by white lines is ground under repair from which play is prohibited. If a player's ball lies in the area, or if it interferes with the player's stance or swing the player must drop in the nearest dropping zone to where their ball originally lay (even though the nearest dropping zone may be nearer the hole.)

PROTECTION OF YOUNG TREES IDENTIFIED BY STAKE AND / OR TREE GUARD.

If such a tree or guard interferes with a player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the ball **must** be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with the procedure in **Rule 24 – 2b**.

SURVEYING STAKES (HOLES 4, 7, 10, 11, 12, 13, 15, 16, 18 & Practice Fairway)

All surveying stakes are immovable obstructions. **Rule 24-2**. Relief from an immovable obstruction, when taken, shall be taken by dropping the ball within one club length of the nearest point of relief, not nearer the hole.

WATERING EQUIPMENT

All watering equipment, including hoses, taps, tap boxes and sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under **Rule 24-2**. In addition, if a ball lies off the putting green but not in a hazard and such an obstruction on or within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may take relief as follows:

The ball shall be lifted and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which a) is not nearer the hole, b) avoids such intervention, and c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green. The ball may be cleaned when so lifted.

WHEEL, AERATION & SCARIFYING MARKS

A ball coming to rest in a wheel, aeration or scarifying mark through the green may be lifted and dropped at the nearest point of relief, not nearer the hole.

A ball coming to rest in a wheel, aeration or scarifying mark on the putting green may be placed at the nearest point of relief, not nearer the hole.

DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES

Distance measuring devices may be used.

Distance markers on the fairway are measured to the centre of the green, and are immovable obstructions.

(Rule 24-2)

100 metres – Red

150 metres – Blue

200 metres - Yellow

SURFACES OF ROADS AND PATHS

All artificial roads and paths are immovable obstructions. (**Rule 24-2**)

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULE

Match play - loss of hole.

Stroke play - 2 shots.
