### TO BE READ IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE RULES OF GOLF AND ANY TEMPORARY LOCAL RULES

#### 1. OUT OF BOUNDS.

All ground beyond boundary fences, and including Club house area, car parks, irrigation tanks, sheds and dams as fenced, signed or marked with black topped stakes or lines.

(Rule 27-1)

#### 2. WATER HAZARDS.

- Water hazards are defined by yellow stakes and / or lines. Lateral water hazards are defined by red stakes and / or lines.  
- During play of the 14th hole a ball which is lost or lies in the lateral water hazard to the rear of the 14th green, under penalty of one stroke, the player may drop a ball within the nearest dropping zone.  
- On the 15th hole it is permitted to play a provisional ball if there is reasonable evidence that the ball is lost in the lateral water hazard. The ball shall be played provisionally under any of the available options under (Rule 26-1). If a provisional ball is played and the original ball is in the lateral water hazard, the player may play the original ball as it lies or continue with the provisional ball in play.

#### 3. WATERING EQUIPMENT.

All watering equipment are to be treated as immovable obstructions.

(Rule 24-2).

#### 4. SURFACES OF ROADS AND PATHS.

All artificial roads and paths are immovable obstructions. (Rule 24-2).

#### 5. GROUND UNDER REPAIR.

- All areas are clearly marked. (Rule 25-1)  
- All GUR stakes, signs and ropes are immovable obstructions. (Rule 24-2).

#### 6. DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES

Distance measuring devices may be used.

Distance markers on the fairway are measured to the centre of the green, and are immovable obstructions. (Rule 24-2).

100 metres – RED      150 metres – BLUE      200 metres - YELLOW
